

Our Guest Performers

Nathan Osmond is making a name for himself in the Country Music world with four consecutive #I hit singles. He's shared the stage with such names as Carrie Underwood, Chris Young, Martina McBride, Lonestar, Alabama and more. He was



recently nominated as "New Artist of the Year," "Male Vocalist of the Year" and "Country Breakthrough Artist of the Year" by the New Music Awards in Los Angeles. On top of his musical talents, Nathan was also selected as one of the Ten Outstanding Young Americans of 2013 by the United States Junior Chamber (The JAYCEES) for his musical achievements and humanitarian efforts. He also just won Music Video of the Year

at the Filmed In Utah Awards, the first ever Utah Music Award in the Country category and the first-ever John C. Maxwell Leadership Award 2014 in the category of Arts & Entertainment all this year.

Nathan is also the host of a hot new television show called "Backstage Avenue" on CBS/KMYU with his co-host Amy Whitcomb from NBC's "The Voice." This singer/songwriter has always called Utah home, even though he spends a great deal of his time in Nashville and on the road touring.



- Watch the conductor when the music stops to decide whether or not to applaud. Some musical works have several movements and the audience applauds only after all movements have been performed.
